PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

HHD 5529 is a one-component, solvent-free, moisture curing polyurethane adhesive. Once it has been dispensed, the adhesive will react with ambient moisture or water content of the substrates to yield a cross-linked thermoset adhesive. HHD 5529 contains a fluorescent agent allowing for UV inspection.

METHOD OF USE

HHD 5529 can be applied through a usual syringe type melting equipment. The weight of coating can vary according on the substrates and applications.

HHD 5529 has been specifically designed for touch panel bonding.

STORAGE

HHD 5529 should be stored in a dry place at a temperature ranging between 15°C and 25°C. It should be processed immediately after the container has been opened.

CURING TIME

The cure rate depends on the substrate type, moisture permeability and ambient conditions. HHD 5529 exhibits high strength instantly after being joined. However, optimum properties can be attained after one to five days at room temperature.

PACKAGING

30mL – White PP plastic syringes

CLEANING

Remove uncured waxy material by scraping with a putty knife or similar tool. For cured material, remove by cutting or sanding. Do not use any heat or flame fire to remove adhesive.
